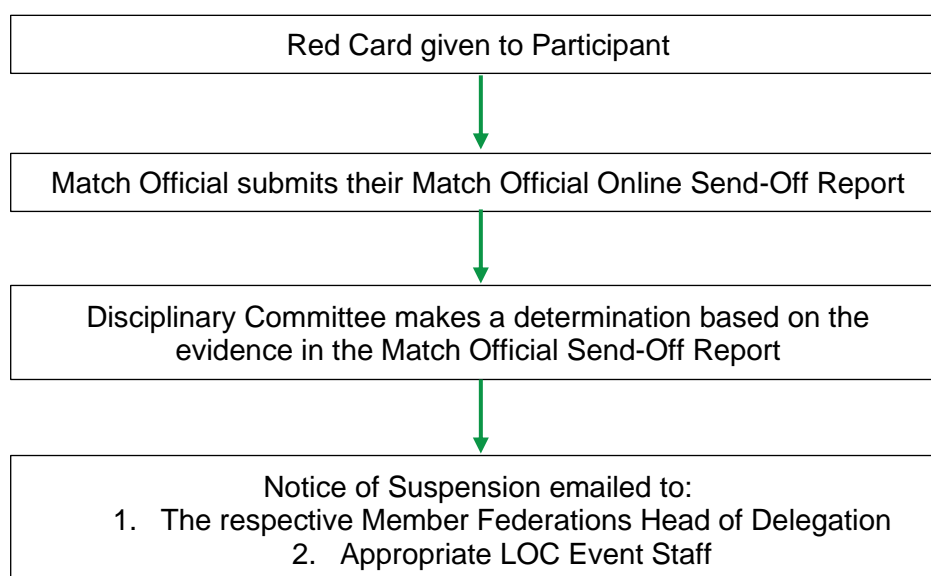




2020 DISCIPLINARY PROCESS FFA NATIONAL FUTSAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

Suspension Process

The following flow chart reflects the process of the disciplinary action from a Red Card:



Note: No Notice of Suspension will be issued for an R7 offence (two yellow cards received in the same match) as the player will be required to serve a mandatory one (1) match suspension.

Appeal of Red Card Suspension

- Within 4 hours submit **Prescribed Form 3** along with \$750 (check form for banking details).
- Except in the case of obvious error, there is no appeal from a minimum match suspension.
- Participants to submit video/photo evidence as part of their case.

Yellow Card Accumulation

- A Player will be required to serve a mandatory one (1) match suspension should they receive:
 - three (3) yellow cards during the Group Stage;
 - two (2) yellow cards during the Championship Stage.

Fielding Ineligible Players

- It is the Member Federation's responsibility to only field eligible players.
- If a team fields an ineligible player then the Match will be deemed a forfeit as per the 2020 FFA National Futsal Championships Competition Regulations (Section 2, Article 13 on Page 8).
